

I'll update this page after I have been given access to Hope Lutheran Church and get answers to these sorts questions from the church personnel and/or the BOE Staff.

- Which church building will be used as the polling place? I would like to indicate it on the map.
- What access routes are allowed, e.g., via Trentini Ave.? OK with those homeowners for many voters to use that street? Per Google Earth, at the exit from the church parking lot to Trentini Ave. there is a "No Thru Traffic" sign for going on that street. Applies to voters? Any special signs needed from the BOF?
- Any parking lot restrictions at the church, e.g., are voters allowed to use only certain areas?
- Are there any parochial school considerations? Buses? Carpool lines? Times? Church school closed when WCPSS schools are closed via "teacher workdays"?
- Are there restrooms and kitchen facilities available to the Precinct Officials?
- What restrooms are campaigners allowed to use in which building?
- Will there be any special signs warning about the 19-23/19-24 polling place entrances so close together on Rogers Road?
- For voting enclosure: Adequate furniture, lighting, electric outlets?
